## 19. Shri Sandeep Harit

At the outset, Shri M.C. Mehra, Vice President, welcomed all the members present at the 40th meeting of SIAA&CBC and thanked them for attending the meeting to deliberate upon matters concerning the ongoing activities and future activities of the Society.

2. With the permission of the Chair, Dr. T.R. Naval, General Secretary, placed the agenda items before the members for discussion.

3. Before putting the agenda Dr. T.R. Naval, General Secretary announced that Sh. R.N. Poonia, Treasurer made a payment of Rs. 12160 /- for the renewal of website committee to the Stunning Solutions, a firm that is maintain the website, [www.siaacbc.org](http://www.siaacbc.org) for next year from March 2026 to February 2027 and when he requested him to prepare a cheque for the said amount in his favour, Ld. Treasurer desired that that amount may be treated as his Annual Contribution for the Calendar Year 2026. Dr. T.R. Naval, General Secretary expressed his sincere thanks on his own behalf and on behalf of the Society. He also informed Ld. Members that in past Sh. P.C. Pankaj, President, and he (Dr. T.R. Naval, General Secretary) has also made Contribution of Rs. 10,000 /- for the entire calendar year. He also thanked the Ld. Members who have contributed for this meeting either by UPI/Paytm or by Cash. Account of the Receipts will be placed in the next meeting.

### **Agenda No. 1: Approval of Minutes of the 9th and 10th Meetings of the Society.**

4. The minutes of the 9th and 10th meetings were circulated to the members for consideration. After brief deliberation, the members expressed their satisfaction about the correctness of the proceeding recorded in the minutes and unanimously approved the minutes.

### **Agenda No. 2: To discuss the plan for celebration of the 6th Foundation Day of SIAA&CBC on 19 March 2026.**

5. Dr. T.R. Naval informed Ld. Members that, as decided in the earlier Governing Body Meeting, Hon'ble Justice Suresh Kaith (Retired Chief

Justice, Madhya Pradesh High Court) had been proposed to be invited as the Chief Guest for the Foundation Day celebration. However, after seeking an appointment, it was learnt that Justice Kaith would not be available on 19 March 2026 due to prior commitments.

6. Dr. Naval thereafter suggested that Shri Rakesh Pawaria, IPS, Additional Commissioner of Police, Delhi may be invited to grace the occasion as the Chief Guest to deliver keynote address and informed Ld. Members that he had already communicated with him in this regard. The proposal was discussed and received the approval and consensus of the members present.

7. Ld. Members also authorized the Executive Members to extend invitations to three more dignitaries or specialists in their respective field to address the august gathering.

8. The members also deliberated upon the venue for the Foundation Day celebration. Various suggestions were made, including Constitution Club and Surjeet Singh Bhawan. It was agreed that the final venue would be decided keeping in view the convenience of respected members, special invitees, and logistical feasibility. It was also decided that as Surjeet Singh Bhawan is less expensive than the constitutional club, so first preference will be to find out the availability of Surjeet Singh Bhawan for 19.03.2026 for the evening timings. It was also agreed that necessary arrangements for the dinner, Hi Tea, photography and videography should be made in time.

9. It was also decided that keeping view the previous experience, it would be proper if the foundation day is celebrated for a longer time, i.e., from 4 PM to 10 PM as on previous occasions many of the respected invitees could not be given time to address the august gathering due to paucity of time.

10. The august gathering also decided to arrange a dinner on this occasion and also invite spouses of Ld. Members.

11. It was also agreed that every member of the society will find out the like-minded persons and invite them to attend the 6<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day, so that more persons may get acquainted with the society, its objects and the

activities. That may help in expansion of vision activities and membership of the society.

12. It was also agreed that as arranged previously every executive member will make sincere efforts for making the event a grand success.

### **CELEBRATION OF BIRTH DAY OF LD. MEMBERS**

13. Dr. T.R. Naval apprised Ld. Members that in last meeting it was decided to celebrate the birthdays of members whose birthdays fall in the month of March onwards. The birthdays of Dr. Sunil Kumar, Shri Ram Singh Chaudhary, Shri Mange Ram and Shri Ravi Kumar fall in this month. Out of them Shri Ram Singh Chaudhary, Shri Mange Ram and Shri Ravi Kumar were present in the meeting and accordingly during the meeting, a cake-cutting ceremony was organized to celebrate birthdays of Shri Ram Singh Chaudhary, Shri Mange Ram and Shri Ravi Kumar followed by Hi Tea. Dr. Sunil Kumar could not come due to his prior commitments. All members extended their warm wishes to them.

### **Agenda No. 3: To discuss recent cases of atrocities on SC's/ST's for taking remedial action.**

14. Shri Rahul Verma, Joint Joint Secretary put up agenda for discussion. Dr. T.R. Naval also apprised Ld. Members that extensive work is in progress to scrutinise all the decisions of Hon`ble Apex Court and various High Courts. Some of the cases have been identified for remedial action. He emphasised on the point that there is urgent need to prepare data bank of all the experts in the field of law, Health physical and mental, education, etc. to find out the cases to be challenged for remedial action, topics on maintaining good health and acquiring best education in every field of knowledge. He appealed to the Ld. Members to extend their fullest support in this endeavour for the benefit of the Target Group.

### **Agenda No. 4: To discuss issuance of various RTI Applications**

15. Shri Rahul Verma, Joint Joint Secretary put up this Agenda for discussion. Dr. T.R. Naval informed Ld. Members that three replies have been received in which some of the information has been supplied but major

information was not supplied. He requested Shri Rahul Verma, Joint Secretary to examine the information given in the replies and draft RTI Application for getting the desired result. After brief discussion Shri Rahul Verma, Joint Joint Secretary was authorized to do all necessary acts to get the desired information.

**Agenda No.5: Update of Registration of Journal AAJ**

16. Shri Rahul Verma, Joint Secretary put up this Agenda for discussion. Dr. T.R. Naval apprised Ld. Members that registration of the Society's Journal titled 'AAJ' is still pending at the stage of registration. He informed Ld. Members about certain procedural roadblocks currently being faced in the registration process and requested cooperation of all members in resolving the issue at the earliest. It was suggested by one of the Ld. Member that help of Shri T.S. Varun may be taken. Shri T.S. Varun instantly agreed to help in this matter and assured the members that he would follow up and assist in expediting the process.

**Agenda No. 6: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.**

17. Dr. T.R. Naval thereafter initiated a discussion regarding the finalization of dates for future meetings of the Society as agreed in the last meeting. He suggested that meetings may be organized on important occasions connected with social justice and significant International days such as the birth anniversaries of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and Mahatma Jyotiba Phule, as well as important United Nations designated days such as Labour Day and Human Rights Day. After discussion, a consensus emerged among the members that meetings of the Society shall be held henceforth as per the calendar approved by the General Body.
